



Winnebago Flying Club - Application for Membership

The club airplane, N7770G, is a 1971 Cessna 172. This is a 150 H.P., four-seat aircraft certified for flight under IFR, with VOR and GPS navigation radios.

Dues are \$30.00 per month and the airplane rents for \$85.00 per Hobbs hour. Aircraft scheduling is done via internet or telephone through aircraftclubs.com and flight instruction is available from any of several club instructors.

Spring, summer and fall monthly meetings are held on the first Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. at hangar C-5 of the north T-hangars. Enter through the automatic gate located on Knapp Street, just east of the Oshkosh Post Office. Winter meetings are held on the first Saturday of the month at the Oshkosh Airport terminal (upstairs), starting at 8:30 a.m.

To make application to the Winnebago Flying Club, simply fill out the attached application and send it, along with the initial non-refundable membership fee of \$150.00. Club members self-insure to cover the deductible portion of any property insurance claim, as it states in our by-laws. The premium for this insurance is \$12 per year. For the \$12 premium, you are getting \$1000 worth of deductible coverage. When you send in your application, please include a separate check for \$12 for the self-insurance premium. The reason we ask for a separate check is because we keep the insurance fund separate from the general fund
